At the outset, Director (Ceremonials), Ministry of Defence welcomed all present and informed the purpose of the meeting for Independence Day Celebrations, 2026. During the meeting, the following points were discussed and decided: -

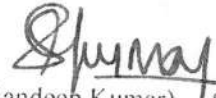
1. All Ministries/Departments of the Government of India were requested to organize various activities, competitions, contests, quizzes and similar events linked with the Independence Day Celebrations-2026, with the objective of creating awareness and enthusiasm about the national festival among youth and the general public across the country. In this regard, following guidelines may be observed:

- a. The activities/competitions/quizzes may be organised on themes related to the Independence Day Celebrations or to the respective subject areas of the organising Ministries/Departments to create awareness among citizens.
- b. The activities may be conducted in online, offline or hybrid mode, as considered suitable and appropriate by the concerned Ministry/Department. In case of offline events, the finals may be conducted at prominent location.
- c. The activities/competitions may also be hosted on the MyGov and My Bharat portals for online mode. Details of the Nodal Officers for both portals are as under:

- d. The organising Ministry/Departments may award prizes to winners, such as cash awards or any other suitable prizes, as decided by their respective Competent Authorities in the matter.
- e. In addition to the prizes/awards given by the organising Ministries/Departments, the Ministry of Defence will invite the top 30 winners of each event organised by every Ministry/Department to witness the Independence Day Ceremony (IDC), subject to receipt of necessary details as per **Annexure-II** by 31st July, 2026.
- f. It was clarified that the Ministry of Defence will neither bear nor reimburse any travel, lodging, or related expenses of the invited winners to witness the IDC. However, the concerned Ministries/Departments may consider bearing or reimbursing such expenses for their participants as approved by their respective Competent Authorities.
- g. Ministries/Departments may also organise activities requiring no expenditure or prizes. In such cases as well, the top 30 participants, as decided by them, may be invited by the Ministry of Defence to witness the Independence Day Ceremony, subject to submission of the required participant's details by 31st July, 2026 as per **Annexure-II**.

- h. Before hosting any activity on any platform or mode, the concerned Ministry/Department should inform the Ministry of Defence so that the activities can be included on a common landing page for the Independence Day Celebrations on the respective portals.
- i. The details of the top 30 winners/participants of each event should reach the Ministry of Defence by 31st July, 2026 to facilitate issuance of online invitation cards for witnessing the Independence Day Ceremony.
- j. Each Ministry/Deptt. may organise multiple events.
- k. For reference purposes, sample activities/competitions/contests along with their terms and conditions, as hosted by the Ministry of Defence for Independence Day Celebrations-2026, on MyGov and My Bharat Portals are enclosed at **Annexure-III**.
- l. The presentation displayed during the meeting is also enclosed at **Annexure-IV**.
- m. All the competitions should be open to participation by public at large. This may not be restricted to office employees only.
- n. All the themes, questions, evaluation are to be decided by respective Ministry/Deptt.
- o. Special effort may be undertaken to popularise the event for maximum participation, specially among students.
